



Substance Use Disorder Therapist

This is a full-time employee position for a Master level Counselor or Social Worker with a MCBAP Development Plan or a CAADC. This therapist is responsible for providing assessment, individualized therapy, and group work (treatment, engagement and prevention) with teens and adult clients who self-refer, are referred by LCMHA, or a treatment court. Therapists work as part of a team with a Certified Peer Coach and a Caseworker. Flexibility with work hours is required as some groups run in the early evenings.
